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ORDER:

In the letter 1st read, above Government of India have communicated the allocation under Pradhan Mantri - Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (PM-RKVY) Cafeteria schemes for the year 2025-26. Among

others, Government of India has made an allocation of Rs.112.58 crore as the Central share under Pradhan Mantri - Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (PM-RKVY) – Detailed Project Report (DPR) based projects for the year 2025-26. Including the 40% State share, the total allocation works out to Rs.187.633 crore. In the letter 2nd read above, new Projects worth Rs.274.6702 crore (1st year outlay – Rs.233.2744 crore and 2nd year outlay - Rs.41.3958 crore) and proposal to allocate administrative fund up to 2.5% to Nodal agency (TAWDEVA) were approved by the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) under DPR based projects for the year 2025-26. In the letter 3rd read above, Government of India have communicated the approval of new projects worth Rs.190.3461 crore (only 1st year outlay) under DPR based projects for the year 2025-26 given by the Project Approval Committee (PAC) chaired by the Secretary, Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India.

2. In the letter 4th read above, a proposal requesting approval of the project PP.No.23.16 –“Supporting Structures for Horticulture Crops” of Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops to the tune of Rs.1788.90 lakh has been sent to Government of India.

3. In the letter 5th read above, Government of India, have released the central share of Rs.5629 lakh as 1st installment under PM Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (PMRKVY) DPR-based Projects. The total first instalment including the corresponding 40% state share of Rs.3752.67 crore works out to Rs.9381.67 lakh.

4. In the G.O (2D) No.93, Agriculture – Farmers Welfare (AP1) Department, dated 23.05.2025 orders were issued according administrative sanction for an outlay Rs.16873.522 lakh and financial sanction to the tune of Rs.8631.667 lakh (Rs.9381.667 lakh - Rs.750 lakh of PP.No.23.16) as 1st instalment fund of 2025-26 towards the implementation of PMRKVY-DPR projects and Rs.750.00 lakh has been set aside from the above total release for the project PP.No.23.16 – “Supporting Structures for Horticulture Crops” pertaining to the Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, pending approval from Government of India.

5. In the letter 7th read above, Government of India has communicated the approval of the project “PP.No.23.16 - Supporting Structures for horticulture crops” of Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops to the tune of Rs.1788.90 lakh under DPR based projects of PM RKVY 2025-26.

6. Based on the above approval given by the Government of India, in the letter 8th read above, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has requested to accord administrative sanction for **PP.No.23.16 - Supporting Structures for horticulture crops** for an outlay **Rs.1500.00 lakh** and financial sanction to the tune of **Rs.750.00 lakh** as 1st instalment fund of 2025-26 towards the implementation of the above project and to accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.43.20 lakh to the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops towards additional

subsidy of 20% for Small Marginal farmers of SC and ST category for the above said scheme.

7. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, hereby accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.1500.00 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.750.00 as first Installment fund for the implementation of the project "PP.No.23.16-Supporting Structures for horticulture crops under PM RKVY – DPR Based Projects for the year 2025-26".

8. The Government accords financial sanction for a sum of Rs.43.20 lakh to the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops towards additional subsidy of 20% for Small Marginal farmers of SC and ST category for implementation of the project "PP.No.23.16-Supporting Structures for horticulture crops" under NADP/PMRKVY-DPR for the year 2025-26 through IFHRMS (Treasury mode)

9. The amount sanctioned in para.7 and 8 above shall be debited to the following Head of Accounts:

The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw the fund sanctioned at para 7 above and disburse the funds towards the implementation of the project **PP.No.23.16-Supporting Structures for horticulture crops under PM RKVY – DPR Based Projects** by the Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops during the financial year 2025-26 through the new fund flow mechanism SNA – SPARSH model.

11. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to implement this scheme through the new fund flow mechanism SNA-SPARSH mode as mandated by the financial procedure outlined by the Government of India and allowed to change the targets between approved components based on the requirements. The Government also inform that the bills shall be presented in IFHRMS - SNA -SPARSH bill module for 100% under any of the head above, which will be divided into Government of India and State share by the system itself, (i.e.) there will not be concept of separate head of account for State and Government of India Share hereafter.

12. As the expenditure is to be incurred through various drawals, as and when expenditure is incurred, by various DDOs mapped under the scheme, the Director of Agriculture is directed to ensure that the overall expenditure based on this G.O. don't exceed the sanctioned amount in the G.O., together all the DDOs under the scheme.

13. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to strictly adhere to the SNA-SPARSH guidelines issued in Government Letter No.573, Finance (PFMS) /2024, dated 06.01.2025 and 17.02.2025.

14. The Government direct the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops to follow the operational guidelines annexed to this order for implementation of the Project.

15. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is permitted to issue necessary executive instructions in continuation of the guidelines issued, as and when situation arises and to fix the Physical target based on the need and potential of the districts.

16. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to follow the directions given in the G.O. 7th read above while implementing the project.

17. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.10600473/ Fin(Agri.-F.W.)/ 2025, dated 26.06.2025.

Dated 26.06.2025]**

PM RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJANA (PM RKVY)- DPR based projects – PP.No.23.16 – “Supporting Structure for Horticulture Crops”

General guidelines:

1. The beneficiary selection should be done only through online mode (uzhavar App/ <https://www.tnhorticulture.tn.gov.in/> tnhortnet/login.php)
2. The Block officials should select the beneficiaries during the beginning of the financial year for proper and speedy implementation of the scheme
3. The Joint / Deputy Director of Horticulture in the district is the Implementing Head in implementation of the Scheme as per the guidelines
4. The Assistant Director of Horticulture in the block is the accepting authority for the selection of beneficiary in implementing the scheme
5. The Assistant Horticulture Officer and the Horticulture Officer of the block are jointly responsible for the selection of farmers ascertaining their social status / category, gender with all the eligibility norms
6. The selected farmers should have own land/ leased land (10 years registered lease) to the eligible extent to avail the benefit of the scheme.
7. The selected farmers should be an active account holder with any of the nationalized /scheduled / co-operative banking organizations in order to facilitate the DBT (Direct Benefit Transfer)
8. The selected farmer should have enrolled himself in the UIDAI (Unique Identification Authority of India) programme of Government of India and should link his Aadhar number with his bank account (Aadhar seeded beneficiary)
9. The selected beneficiary should produce evidence towards his residence proof apart from Aadhar ie., either ration card / Voter ID / Driving license / Passport / or any other proof of residence issued by the Competent Authority and Farmer ID generated in Farmers Registry should also be recorded.
10. New farmers who have not availed subsidy / benefit should be selected. The subsidy availed by the farmer in the previous years should be verified before processing, to avoid repetition of beneficiaries.
11. All farmers who have own land/ Registered Leased land are eligible. Priority shall be given to SF/MF/SC/ST/Women and then the other Category farmers. 70% of the fund should be earmarked for SM / MF Farmers.

12. For additional 20% funds in case of Small/Marginal Farmers of SC/ST Category for high value components like Pandal, the farmers should mandatorily keep SC/ST certificate and SF/MF Certificate issued from Revenue Department. Only after ascertaining the above, additional 20% funds should be recommended.
13. The due cash assistance should be extended to the beneficiary after getting satisfied with all the scheme activities in the field by adopting DBT method to his/her bank account directly avoiding any other means of transaction
14. If the assistance has to be given to the farmer through DBT, utmost care should be taken in getting relevant valid Bank Account details for releasing the subsidy through DBT
15. Work orders should be issued for Pandal Structures on submission of necessary valid documents.
16. If the selected farmer does not adhere to the timeline, notice must be issued to the concerned person, followed by issuance of cancellation of work order. Justification for elimination should be recorded and new beneficiary should be selected as per seniority.
17. The maximum eligibility of a farmer to avail assistance under Permanent Pandal is one Ha.
18. The permanent pandal field should be converged with Micro Irrigation
19. The scheme will be implemented in all districts except Chennai.
20. The fund allocation is to be made in General (78.89%), SC (20.01%) and ST (1.1%) categories without any deviation.
21. For Permanent Pandal System work order should be issued after thoroughly verifying the documents. For Pandal, various stages of erecting of Pandal structures should be documented in a spiral Book and maintained in the respective block office.
22. The permanent Pandal system created under PM RKVY-DPR should be geo tagged by using BHUVAN / Krishimapper - RKVY mobile application which is mandatory for fund release.
23. Field photos should be taken before, during and post implementation of the scheme in the field for all the components with geo-coordinates and should be documented.
24. ADH/ HO/ Dy.HO/ AHO of their area should ensure the proper implementation of the scheme by field inspection at various stages
25. The block officials should inspect the field, verify the Vouchers and Certify with page entry of various works submitted by the farmer and ensure that the items are found correct.
26. Follow up register should be maintained for each component beneficiary-wise and the yield, income generated, etc and other parameters should be recorded.
27. The Horticultural crop cultivated should be brought into Digital Crop Survey and Adangal / e-adangal before release of subsidy. Block ADH and JDH/DDH of the concerned district should ensure the entry of the crop in adangal before release of subsidy.

The following project has been approved for implementation under PM RKVY – DPR for the year 2025-26 in addition to already approved projects of Area expansion of Horticulture crops (PP.No.23.14) and Infrastructure Development (PP.No.23.18).

Eligibility: The maximum eligibility of a farmer to avail assistance under Permanent Pandal is one Ha. The Farmer who had availed assistance for Pandal (1Ha) is not eligible to avail assistance again.

Subsidy cost:

Permanent Pandal – subsidy - Rs 3.00 Lakh/Ha

1. Supporting structures for Horticultural crops - Permanent Pandal system

- Total cost – Rs.6 lakh/ Ha, Subsidy – 50% (Rs.3 lakh/ ha)
- Horticultural crops like Gourds vegetables, Beans, Peas, Grapes, Kiwi fruit, Passion fruit, etc. are eligible

- The field erected with Pandal should be Jointly Verified with the concerned ADH and Block officials along with other Block ADH.
- The infrastructure created should be Geotagged and should be uploaded in Bhuvan app / Krishimapper before the release of subsidy by the concerned Block officials.
- The District officer should ensure that the assets created should be uploaded in Bhuvan app / Krishimapper before the release of subsidy.
- The Pandal field should be converged with Micro Irrigation, if possible, for reaping maximum benefits.
